

6 IMPROVEMENTS TO DRAINAGE NORTH OF EMMOCK WOODS HOUSING DEVELOPMENT (AN44-2012)

The City Engineer has identified drainage and maintenance improvement works within Dundee City Council owned land which would reduce the risk of flooding to properties in William Fitzgerald Way. The works will take the form of removing an existing filter trench, which is no longer functioning effectively, and replacing it with a grassed swale which will divert overland flow from the field to an existing watercourse to the west.

Approval is sought to accept an offer of £9,379.50 from the Environment Department Construction Division which demonstrates favourable rates for carrying out these works. The total cost of the works is £14,000, inclusive of professional fees and contingencies.

The Director of Finance has confirmed that the expenditure can be met from the City Development Capital Plan 2012/2013.
