

10 BROUGHTY FERRY SEASIDE AWARD (YELLOW FLAG) AND BLUE FLAG INITIATIVE - FORMER BROUGHTY FERRY BATHING SHELTER (AN486-2004)

Reference is made to Article III of the minute of meeting of this Committee of 17th March 2003 at which the Committee agreed to accept an offer of £1,275 from Ritchie Dagan & Allen, Chartered Architects to provide architectural services for the conversion of the Eastern portion of the former bathing shelter for use as a Lifeguard Station.

The Committee is now requested to agree a contribution of £15,000 from the Quality of Life Fund for 2005/06, towards the development of this portion of the building. The remainder of the building is being refurbished by the Leasee for use as a Café/Restaurant.

The refurbishment of this building supports the Council's application which has been submitted to ENCAMS for the award of a Blue Flag/Seaside Award for Broughty Ferry beach in 2005. Work is scheduled to be completed by June 2005 in time for the 2005 summer bathing season.
