

8 RESTORATION OF PERIMETER WALLS AT CAMPERDOWN PARK (AN51-2016)

Following an inspection by the City Engineers, on infrastructure related to parks, the North West section of the wall at Camperdown which borders the Gourdie Brae was deemed to be in need of restoration.

It is therefore proposed to carry out works including repointing this section of the wall in order to prevent further deterioration, and to ensure the integrity of the wall in long-term. Camperdown wall is a Grade A listed structure and the Council's Conservation Officer is content with the proposed works.

A quote was sought from the Construction Services Division for the wall restoration works, and it was estimated that the cost for the works required would be approximately £30,000. It is planned to undertake a full condition survey which we anticipate will identify a requirement for an ongoing commitment in the Capital Works Programme.

The Executive Director of Corporate Services advises that the above costs of £30,000 can be met from allowances within the Recreation, Culture, Arts & Heritage: Parks and Open Space section of the Capital Plan 2016-2021.

It is recommended that the above proposal be approved and the Construction Services Division be authorised to undertake these works. It is anticipated that this project will be completed by 31st March, 2017.
