4 CITY CENTRE EVENT - DUNDEE UNITED SCOTTISH CUP - 16TH MAY, 2010 (AN74-2010)

In the event of Dundee United Football Club winning the Active Nation Scottish Cup on Saturday, 15th May 2010, then it is proposed that the City Council will host a celebration event in the City Centre on Sunday, 16th May, 2010.

In collaboration with Dundee United, the Council plans to host an open-top bus journey with the team, a reception in the City Chambers, and the presentation of the Scottish Cup on the balcony at the City Chambers. In order to deliver this event safely stewarding, barriers, and a daylight screen are required.

It is estimated that the total cost of hosting this event will be £18,700, and it is proposed that this sum be met from the Common Good Fund.

If Dundee United do not win the Active Nation Scottish Cup then the proposed event will not take place, however the City Council will still incur expenditure of £4,800 for deposits.

The Committee is asked to agree to £18,700 being incurred on the proposed event should Dundee United Football Club win the Active Nation Scottish Cup, and £4,800 if the event does not take place, and that this expenditure be funded from the Common Good Fund.
