**1. PURPOSE OF REPORT**

To advise Committee of a request from the University of Dundee to support research projects relating to sustainability and recycling, and to recommend a response.

**2. RECOMMENDATIONS**

It is recommended that Committee agree to:

- a) make a 'one-off' contribution of £5,000 towards the cost of the research projects
- b) authorise the Chief Executive to send letters of support for the projects

**3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

It is recommended that the £5,000 expenditure be met from the Common Good Fund.

**6. BACKGROUND**

- 6.1 The Council has been approached by Professor R K Dhir, Director of the Concrete Technology Unit in the Department of Civil Engineering at the University of Dundee. The Unit is acknowledged as a world class centre of research, with a strong record of partnership with industry. Over £2.5m of research projects relating to sustainability and recycling have been carried out since 1995 and over £1m of further projects are under consideration.
- 6.2 The Unit is currently submitting external funding bids for a number of new projects, which will create research jobs in Dundee, enhance the city's reputation as a centre of excellence in academic research and expand knowledge in relation to the use of waste materials as part of a commitment to sustainable construction, which will have long-term benefits for the environment. Commitment from local government will enhance the prospect of successful bids, and the Unit has requested letters of support along with a contribution towards the cost of a range of projects.

6.3 It is recommended that Committee agree to:

- make a 'one-off' contribution of £5,000 towards the cost of the research projects, this expenditure to be met from the Common Good Fund
- authorise the Chief Executive to send letters of support for the projects
