6.0 BACKGROUND

- **6.1** Tenders were invited from four contractors for the uplift and removal to DERL of clinical waste from schools and other sites in Dundee for the period 1 April 2006 to 31 March 2009.
- 6.2 One tender was received from Co-An, Railway Road, Welton Industrial Estate, Blairgowrie PH10 3EP for the uplift and disposal of clinical waste.

As this is a specialist service there is a limited supply of contractors and has resulted in a single tender submission. On this basis it is recommended that the contract for the uplift and disposal of clinical waste only be awarded to Co-An, Railway Road, Welton Industrial Estate, Blairgowrie PH10 3EP. A breakdown of the schedule may be viewed at Dryburgh Education Centre, Napier Drive, Dundee.
