1.0 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 This report details the recommendations of the Director of Social Work on the level of payments for services provided by voluntary organisations for 2001/2002.

3.1 The cost of implementing the recommendations within this report is £1,886,148. This cost can be met from the total 2001/2002 budget provision for payments to voluntary organisations.

6.0 MAIN TEXT

A range of voluntary organisations receive funding from the Social Work Department, as payments for services provided. The provision of these services is governed by a contract or service level agreement with the organisation concerned.

- 6.2 The organisations listed in Appendix 1 all have either contracts or service level agreements with the Social Work Department. The specification and monitoring requirements for these organisations are stringent, and as a minimum each agreement will be reassessed each year to determine the appropriate level of funding for the next year.
- 6.3 A rolling programme of detailed reviews is underway. These examine the content of service level agreements, the level of funding and the appropriateness of varying funding cycles, eg to move to 3 year budgets.

7.1 The Director of Support Services and Director of Finance have been consulted in the preparation of this report.
