RECOMMENDATION

2 RECORDED CRIME

2.1 Dundee LPA evidenced reductions in violent crime when compared to the average of the previous 5 years

A reduction in overall violent crime of 28.9% (55 fewer victims)

A reduction in serious assaults of 24.3% (18 fewer victims)

A reduction in robbery of 48.3% (29 fewer victims)

A reduction in common assault of 5.3% (84 fewer victims)

2.2 Reductions were also achieved in

Housebreaking (including attempts) – all property – 31.6% (178 fewer victims)

Shoplifting – 20.7% (257 fewer victims)

Vandalism – 26.9% (459 fewer victims)

2.3 Overall, Group 1-4¹ recorded 5065 crimes and evidenced a reduction of 18.9% compared with the 5 year average (1180 fewer crimes).

¹ Groups 1-4 refer to an amalgamation of four crime groups. They are Group 1, consisting of violent crime; Group 2 covering sexual offences; Group 3, the largest, covers a wide range of crimes of dishonesty; and Group 4 includes vandalism, fire-raising, and malicious mischief.)

3 DETECTION RATES

3.1 Improvements in detection rates, against the 5 year average were evidenced in the following:-

Serious assault 96.4% - 5 year average 77.2% Robbery 80.6% - 5 year average 57.8% Common assault 75.5% - 5 year average 67.7%

3.2 Detection rates for the following were below the 5 year average

Housebreaking (including attempts) 19.2% - 5 year average 27.7% Shoplifting 81.3% - 5 year average 86.9% Vandalism 24.6% - 5 year average 27.7%

4 ROAD SAFETY

4.1 Reductions were recorded in all three measures of road casualties when compared to the five year average:-

People killed/seriously injured 21 – 5 year average 41 People slightly injured 114 – 5 year average 165 Children killed/slightly injured 2 – 5 year average 8

4.2 Significant detections for the following were above the five year average and this is due to emphasis on enforcement to influence driver behaviour to keep people safe and deny criminals the use of the road networks:-

Speeding 1034 – 5 year average 392 Seat belt offences 553 – 5 year average 96 Mobile phone offences 483 – 5 year average 104

5 PUBLIC PROTECTION

5.1 212 crimes of indecency (Group 2) were recorded, a 35% increase on the 5 year average of 157, with rapes accounting for 20% of the total recorded.

Of the total Group 2 crimes reported, 56% occurred during the current year. The remainder occurred during previous years but were only recently reported. Recent, well publicised cases involving historic abuse have, perhaps, given victims greater confidence to report matters to the police knowing they will be thoroughly investigated. Some of the crimes were linked and involved the same victims and/or perpetrator. There was also an increase in crimes linked to the use of internet and social media.
