1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report details the tenders received for the above project and requests a decision on the acceptance of the lowest tender and allowances.

2.0 **RECOMMENDATIONS**

2.1 It is recommended:-

(1) to approve the acceptance of the lowest tender submitted by Sidey Ltd., Perth in the amount of £420,709.24 and allowances amounting to £145,434.00, giving a total cost of £566,143.24 and

(2) to note that provision for this work will be made in the Housing Department's Capital Plan which will be presented to committee in June 2009.

3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The Head of Finance has stated that the project costs of £566,143.24 can be met from the Housing Department's Capital Plan which has been prepared and will go to committee in June 2009.

4.0 POLICY IMPLICATIONS

4.1 This report has been screened for any policy implications in respect of Sustainability, Strategic Environmental Assessment, Anti-Poverty and Equality Impact Assessment.

There are no major issues.

5.0 TENDER REPORT

- 5.1 The works comprise new heating installations, kitchens and bathrooms to 61 houses in Craigard Road, Craigowan Road and Ravenscraig Road. These houses were to benefit from the Kitchen and Bathroom programme in 2010/2011, however on investigation were found to have gas fired back boilers in around 1990 using communal chimneys as flues. Therefore they have now been prioritised for boiler replacement and it is prudent to advance the kitchen and bathroom renewal to minimise disruption to the tenants by carrying out all the work at the same time. This work is programmed to start on site on 15 June 2009 and provision has been made in the Housing Department's (draft) Capital Plan being prepared for committee.
- 5.2 Four firms were invited to submit tenders and four tenders were received, details of the lowest three being as follows:-
