 - i) each supplier listed in section 2.2 above has been assessed to ensure their business complies with the Race Relations Act 1975.
 - ii) in each case the manufacturer of the equipment listed is increasing the use of recyclable materials in their build processes and all engines fitted meet or exceed all legislation relating to exhaust gas emissions and noise pollution.

iii) each plant item listed will be subject to regular maintenance and testing throughout its operational life to ensure compliance with standards set.
