1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To authorise the purchase of two hook-loading vehicles which are to be used for a range of services within the Waste Management Department.

- (i) to accept the offer from Scania UK for the supply of two Scania hookloaders amounting to £208,828.
- (ii) to note that the vehicles are being procured via the Authorities Buying Consortium (ABC) Heavy Vehicle Framework contract.

3.1 The total cost of the two vehicles is £208,828. Provision for this expenditure has been made in the Waste Management Department's Capital Budget for 2008/09.
