### 1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers a request for alterations to waiting restrictions in Hazlehead Drive and Turnberry Avenue due to inconsiderate parking adjacent to a private vehicular access and close to a junction.

### 2 **RECOMMENDATION**

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the preparation of a Traffic Regulation Variation Order to affect the changes to the waiting restrictions in the relevant Traffic Regulation Order for Dundee.

### 3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 It is proposed that the total cost of implementing these proposals, estimated at £500, be met from within the City Development Car Park Trading Account. An additional £150 is required in annual maintenance costs for signing and lining and this will also be met from within the City Development Department's Car Park Trading Account.

#### Hazlehead Drive/Turnberry Avenue (See Drawing 1) - Strathmartine Ward

As a result of inconsiderate parking adjacent to private vehicular accesses and parking close to a junction, it is necessary to introduce parking restrictions to prohibit vehicles from parking and causing an obstruction.
