6.0 BACKGROUND

- **6.1** Tenders were received from the SEEMIS Group and Pearson/Phoenix in accordance with procedures agreed.
- **6.2** The two suppliers were invited to demonstrate their products to representatives of schools nominated by the department's MIS Strategy Group.
- **6.3** Sessions were also arranged for school clerical staff who operate the current MIS system to have hands-on experience of the two products.

- **6.4** A sub-group of the MIS Strategy group which included representatives from the Information Technology department evaluated the two products against a 49 point checklist of detailed requirements.
- **6.5** The findings of the various groups were reported back to the department's MIS Strategy group. The group concluded that the SEEMIS solution offered a better quality and a lower price.

7.1 This report has been subject to consultation with the Chief Executive, Depute Chief Executive (Finance), Chief Executive (Support Services) and the Head of Information Technology.
