1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report has been produced in response to the requirement to publish locally information about what has been achieved through the allocation of the additional financial resources made available for schools following the Pre-Budget Statement by the Chancellor of the Exchequer in November 2000.

2.0 **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- **2.1** It is recommended that the Education Committee:
 - i. note the detailed information on the utilisation of the additional funding allocated to schools as set out in the appendix to this report.
 - ii. instruct the Director of Education to report to the Scottish Executive Education Department on how the grant has been spent.

3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The Council was given additional funding of £401,320 for allocation to schools which was distributed in accord with the arrangements approved by the Education Committee at its meeting on 15th January 2001 (Report 45-2001 refers).

4.0 LOCAL AGENDA 21 IMPLICATIONS

4.1 The additional funding has assisted pupils access to skills, knowledge and information needed to enable them to play a full part in society.

5.0 EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES IMPLICATIONS

5.1 The additional funding has assisted with equality of access to educational opportunity for pupils.

6.0 BACKGROUND

- **6.1** Circular 5/2000 issued by the Scottish Executive in December 2000 advised that Dundee City Council had been allocated £401,320 to be made available to schools following the Pre-Budget Statement by the Chancellor of the Exchequer on 8 November 2000.
- **6.2** The resources have been allocated on the basis of a fixed amount of £2,800 per school, plus £10 per primary pupil, £15 per secondary pupil and £30 per special school pupil.
- **6.3** It is a condition of payment of this grant that the resources involved must be clearly seen to be additional to existing planned education spending and to spending on individual schools, and that every primary, secondary and special school in the authority must derive some benefit from the use of the resources in this financial year.
- **6.4** It is also a condition of payment of this grant that authorities publish locally information about what has been achieved through allocation of these additional resources.
- 6.5 In addition to the published information it is also a condition of payment that the authority submit by 29 June 2001 a report to the Scottish Executive listing for each school how much has been allocated to it and what that amount has been spent on.

7.0 CONSULTATION

7.1 The Director of Finance, the Director of Support Services and school Head Teachers have been consulted in the preparation of this report.

8.0 BACKGROUND PAPERS

No background papers, as defined by Section 50D of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 (other than any containing confidential or exempt information), were relied on to any material extent in preparing the above Report.
