1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 To seek authority to proceed with ground investigation works on the proposed site of the new Civic Amenity Site at Baldovie.

2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 It is recommended that the committee authorises the City Engineers to carry out an estimated £10,000 worth of site investigations as per the annually agreed unit rate price.

3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 This expenditure totaling an estimated £10,000 will be met from the Waste Management Department's 2005/06 Capital Budget. All future expenditure on the development of this site will be met from Strategic Waste Fund grant.
