1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To authorise the purchase of new specialist grounds maintenance plant required by the Contract Services Department.

- 4.1 As part of an ongoing review of operational plant and equipment, two specialist items of plant have been identified which will provide greater operational efficiency to the work of the Land Services Division. As these items are specialist in nature, negotiations have been undertaken with the respective suppliers to ensure value for money is achieved.
- 4.2 Details of the negotiated offers are included within Appendix A along with details of the background and justification for the proposed purchases.

5. POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- 5.1 The report has been screened for any policy implications in respect of Sustainability, Strategic Environmental Assessment, Anti-Poverty, Equality Impact Assessment and Risk Management.
- 5.2 The major issues identified are:
 - i) each prospective supplier has been assessed to ensure their business complies with the Race Relations Act 1975.
 - ii) in each case all engines fitted meet or exceed legislative requirements regarding exhaust gas emissions and noise pollution.

iii) each item will be subject to regular maintenance and testing throughout its operational life to ensure compliance with standards set.
