6.0 BACKGROUND

- 6.1 The start of Session 2002/2003 was agreed by Dundee City Council Education Committee on 16 October 2000 (Article III refers).
- 6.2 The scheme proposes a school Session of 195 days for teaching staff and 190 for pupils.
- 6.3 In-service days for teaching staff will be 19 August 2002, 14 and 15 November 2002, 23 May 2003 and 1 day in February/March 2003 allocated by secondary school cluster.
- 6.4 The proposed spring holiday includes both Good Friday and Easter Monday 2003 (18 and 21 April).
- 6.5 The proposed autumn fortnight is in accordance with established practice and includes the autumn holiday week.

- 6.6 Christmas Day falls on a Wednesday. This means schools will close on Friday 20 December and re-open for the spring term on Monday 6 January 2003.
- 6.7 The end of session will be Thursday 3 July 2003.
