## 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To obtain approval for extending the existing contract.

#### 2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 That approval be given for extending the existing contract and incurring estimated additional expenditure of approximately £279,734.

## 3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The Head of Finance has stated that the additional expenditure can be funded from the overall allowance of £1,400,000 for Controlled Entry works within the Housing Department's Capital Plan 2007/2008.

#### 4.0 ESTIMATED ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE

- 4.1 Reference is made to Article II of the minute of meeting of the Housing Committee of 16 April 2007 when report No 241-2007 was approved. The report authorised entering into a partnering contract with McGill Electrical Ltd., Dundee to install controlled entry systems to 89 blocks at various locations throughout the city for a total project cost of £976,586.44.
- 4.2 The client has identified a further 47 blocks requiring controlled entry systems which can be completed this year and it is considered prudent to add these to the existing contract with McGill Electrical Ltd. The addresses are on the attached appendix. This is an extension of the current year's programme of tenant only blocks to allow more time for consultation with owners in mixed tenure blocks as their agreement is required before works can proceed.
- 4.3 Approval of this will result in additional expenditure of £279,734 inclusive of an allowance for professional services

## 5.0 **POLICY IMPLICATIONS**

5.1 These installations will promote crime prevention and community safety.

#### 6.0 **CONSULTATIONS**

6.1 The Chief Executive, Depute Chief Executives (Finance and Support Services), Head of Finance and the Director of Housing have been consulted in the preparation of this report.
