1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To seek approval for the designation of the Polling Places listed in the Appendix.

2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 That the Council agree that the boundaries for the Polling Districts as outlined below be approved and that the Polling Stations for use in next year's Scottish Parliament and Local Government elections be as indicated in the Appendix.

5.0 EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES IMPLICATIONS

5.1 The polling stations in use have been chosen with regard to their location and their accessibility for all electors.

6.0 MAIN TEXT

- 6.1 The new Ward boundaries were approved by the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland on 12 July 2006. There were no changes to the boundaries as previously proposed by the Commission.
- A Polling District/Polling Place review has been carried out. Changes to Polling Places have only been made where absolutely necessary and in the main have arisen due to problems caused by the new Ward boundaries not being coterminous with existing Polling District boundaries, areas of population change and the availability of suitable premises.
- 6.3 Members should note that electorate figures quoted are the figures as at June 2006. The annual canvass is currently being undertaken and the final number of electors for each Polling Station will not be known until the publication of the new Register on 1st December 2006. The Register will be published based on the new Ward boundaries.
- Two maps will be on display at the meeting. One map will show the changes referred to below and the second map will show the new Wards together with the new Polling District boundaries and Polling Stations.
- The Appendix to this Report lists the new Wards together with the default Polling Stations for each Polling District within the Ward.
- 6.6 As well as boundary changes, the Electoral Administration Act, 2006 will introduce various other changes to the electoral process. Some changes came into effect on 11th September and the remainder are scheduled to be introduced in the Autumn Parliamentary Session. A briefing paper on the changes will be submitted to a future meeting.

Ward 1 - Strathmartine

Map Area Description of Changes

- 1.1 Electors in WAU (Trottick Mains) will now vote at Sidlaw View Primary as opposed to Mill O' Mains Primary.
- 1.2, 1.3, 1.4 Brackens Primary is being redeveloped as part of the PPP and is therefore unavailable. Alternatives, north of Macalpine Road, within the St Mary's Housing Estate have been examined but all have problems of either physical access to the building, size, lack of parking or location.

The following arrangements based on the realignment of existing Polling Districts are proposed:-

Electors in Area 1.2 (WAN) vote at Macalpine Primary;

Electors in Area 1.3 be added to WAO and vote at the Ardler Complex;

Electors in Area 1.4 be added to WAQ and vote at Strathmartine Church Hall; Electors in Area 1.5 be added to WAN and vote at Macalpine Primary School; and

Electors in Area 1.7 (ACB) vote at Macalpine Primary

1.6 Electors in WAD Drayton Drive will move to WAO and vote at Ardler Complex as opposed to St Clements Primary.

Ward 2 - Lochee

Map Area Description of Changes

- 2.1 Electors in WAK 152 to 186 and 169/173 High Street and Sinclair Street will move to WAY and vote at Lochee West Church Hall as opposed to Kirk Street Sheltered Lounge
- 2.2 Electors in WAG, 2 and 4 Backhill Road, Dalrymple Place, 1, 2 and 3 Dalrymple Street, 1, 3, 5 and 7 Dickson Avenue, 1, 2 and 4 Elmwood Road, 118-188 Glamis Road (evens), Lennox Gardens, 1, 2, 3 and 4 Nevay Terrace and Tarbert Place will move to WAM and vote at Margaret Blackwood Court as opposed to Hillside Primary.

Ward 3 - West End

Map Area Description of Changes

- 3.1 All electors in WAA Perth Road and WAB the grounds of Ninewells Hospital will move to WAL and will now vote at Harris Academy as opposed to Clyde Place Sheltered and Gowriehill Primary respectively.
- 3.2 Electors in WAJ City Road (16-48 evens) will move to WBG and will vote at Scott Street Sheltered Lounge as opposed to Mitchell Street.
- 3.3 Electors in WBQ Corso Street (2-6 evens), Hawkhill (249-255 odds), Peddie Street (2-54 evens) and Tait's Lane will move to WBF and will vote at Logie and St John's Cross Parish Church Hall as opposed to St Peter's Free Church Hall.
- 3.4 Electors in WBQ Annfield Road, Annfield Street, Bellfield Street, Blackness Road (168-212 evens), Blackness Street and Peddie Street (83-101 odds) will move to WAJ and vote at the Al-Maktoum Centre, Blackness Road along with electors in the Larch Street, Daniel Street, Brook Street areas etc. who formerly voted at Mitchell Street. (Polling District WAJ).

Ward 4 - Coldside

Map Area Description of Changes

- 4 4.1 Electors in WAY and WBB 56 Balfield Road and Northtay House, Balfield Road will move to WBA and vote at Cobden Street Sheltered as opposed to Lochee West Church Hall and St David's High Kirk.
 - 4.2 Electors in WAX Clepington Road (288-314 evens), Johnston Avenue (57 to 67 odds) and Glenmoy Avenue (evens) will move to WBB and vote at Lawton Road Sheltered Lounge as opposed to Downfield Primary.
 - 4.3 Electors in WBA Campbell Street (36-66 evens), Gardner Street (5-37 odds), Kilberry Street (11-45 odds), Lawside Road (30-62 evens) and Rankine Street (20-40 evens and 51-59 odds) will move to WBI and will vote at Law Nursery as opposed to Cobden Street Sheltered.
 - Electors in WBB (the Glens area) and WBM (Lawton Road area) are now both within this Ward. The Polling Places are St Davids Church Hall and Lawton Road Sheltered Lounge respectively. Both of these buildings are within WBM and are situated close together. Only one polling place is necessary and that should be Lawton Road Sheltered Lounge as it is Council owned and the access for disabled persons meets the necessary standard.
 - 4.5 Electors in WBH Byron Street (42-56 evens) and WBI Byron Street (58-150 evens) and Lawton Terrace will move to WBM and WBB respectively and will vote Lawton Road Sheltered Lounge as opposed to Hill Street Sheltered and Law Nursery.
 - 4.6 Electors in WBJ Constitution Court, Constitution Crescent, Constitution Road (20-24), Dudhope Crescent Road, Garland Place, Laburn Street, Parker Street, Scrimgeour Place and Smillie Court will move to WBL and will vote at Rosebank Primary School as opposed to Mitchell Street.
 - 4.7 Electors in EBL Clepington Road (262A), Coldside Road (7), Francis Street (2), Hospital Street (3-35 odds), Strathmartine Road (156-226 evens) and Strathmore Avenue (306-368 evens) will move to EBQ and will vote at Francis Wright Pre-School as opposed to Moncur Crescent Sheltered Lounge.
 - 4.8 Electors in EBM Arklay Street (20, 22 and 24 St James Court) and Tannadice Street (2-4) will move to EBP and will vote at Fleming Gardens Lounge as opposed to Melrose Terrace.
 - The number of electors in EBX (Dens Road/Fairbairn Street area) has fallen due to the boundary of EBX being reduced and now stands at only 332. The recommended figure for a single polling station is 1,000 electors. These electors vote at Dens Road Primary. The access to this school is unsuitable for disabled persons and following discussions with Capability Scotland, alternative arrangements were put in place which allowed the premises to be used in 2005. The relatively small number of electors in this area, together with the ongoing access problems, now make the use of this school as a polling place unrealistic and it is recommended therefore that Dens Road Primary be discontinued and that electors in EBX vote at Fleming Gardens Communal Lounge.

Ward 5 - Maryfield

Map Area Description of Changes

- 5.1 Electors in EBX Arklay Court (25-36), Clepington Court (37-65), Clepington Street (5-23 odds), Court Street (2-14 evens), Dundonald Court (66-74), Dundonald Street (12-22 evens), Tannadice Court (1-24), Tannadice Street (1-11 odds) and Wolseley Street (1-16 and 18, 20 and 22) will move to EBM and vote at Dundee College, Melrose Terrace as opposed to Dens Road Primary.
- 5.2 Electors in WBC who voted in the Marryat Hall will vote at 18 City Square as the Caird Hall complex is hosting a major conference and is unavailable.

Ward 6 - North East

Map Area Description of Changes

- 6.1 Electors in EAE, Drumgeith Road, Kirconnel Terrace, Strathaven Terrace, Summerfield Gardens and Summerfield Terrace currently vote in Summerfield Gardens Communal Lounge. This Lounge has been deemed surplus to requirements by the Housing Department and is to be demolished. It is intended that these electors will vote at Newfields Primary School.
- 6.2 Electors in EAE, Whitfield Terrace also use Summerfield Sheltered Lounge and is intended that these electors will be moved to EAD and vote at Whitfield Community Centre.
- 6.3 Electors in EBS Baldovie Road will move to EAS and vote at Newfields Primary School as opposed to Powrie Primary School.

Ward 7 - East End

Map Area Description of Changes

7.1 The former Powrie Primary School in Baluniefield Road has now closed, hence electors in EBS and EAO (Baluniefield Road area of Douglas eastwards) who formerly voted there will now vote at Claypotts Castle Primary (formerly Douglas Primary School).

Ward 8 - The Ferry

Map Area Description of Changes

8.1 Electors in EXT Panmurefield Road area currently vote at the Premier Travel Inn. It is intended that these electors will now vote at Panmurefield Church Hall.

7.1 The Chief Executive, Depute Chief Executive (Support Services), Depute Chief Executive (Finance) and the Political parties represented on the Council have been consulted.
