1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

To seek approval for the purchase of play equipment for the refurbishment of Camperdown Play Complex Phase One

2. RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 It is recommended that the offer from Kompan Ltd, 5 Holdom Avenue, Milton Keynes of £42,138.00 for the supply of specialist play equipment is accepted.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The costs can be met from the provision in 2001/02 Leisure & Parks Department Capital Budget.

4. LOCAL AGENDA 21 IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 The equipment that has been removed will be refurbished or re-used, where possible to improve other areas. The equipment and materials that are not being re-used will be recycled. This will ensure that removal of the play area does not create a problem of excessive disposal of materials and the environmental implications that would result.
- 4.2 All materials have been sourced from renewable resources where possible.
- 4.3 The resulting areas, whether a play area has been removed or refurbished, will be an improvement to the environment of Dundee.

5. EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES IMPLICATIONS

- 5.1 The refurbished play area will be integrated as far as possible to ensure that people of all abilities will be able to access the facility and enjoy a fulfilling play environment along with their peers.
- 5.2 Facilities will be provided to interest children and young people of all ages.

6. **MAIN TEXT**

6.1 Reference is made to article IV of this Committee of 20 November 2000 where the Director of Leisure & Parks was remitted to proceed with detailed costs for the implementation of Phase 2 of the Dundee Play Area Report 2000.

Works programmed for 2001/2002 financial year as part of phase 2 includes the refurbishment of Camperdown Play Complex Phase 1.

6.2 Kompan Ltd are nominated as specialist suppliers for the supply of play equipment for the refurbishment of Camperdown Play Complex Phase One. Their quote for supply only was £42,138.00.

6.3 The Play equipment specified is of a specialist design based on boats and nautical play equipment to continue the theme of the Battle of Camperdown Play Complex.

It is recommended that the Committee accept the quotation from Kompan Ltd. Associated hardworks and installation costs will be reported to a subsequent Committee.
