1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers a request for a review of the waiting restrictions on Perth Road West of Harris Academy, the relocation of disabled parking bays for the V&A Museum and for additions to waiting restrictions for Forthill Road adjacent to Forthill Primary School.

2 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the preparation of a Traffic Regulation Variation Order to affect the changes to the waiting restrictions in the relevant Traffic Regulation Orders for Dundee.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 It is proposed that the total cost of implementing these proposals estimated at £600 to be met from within the City Development Car Park Trading Account. An additional £200 is required in annual maintenance costs for signing and lining and this will also be met from within the City Development Department's Car Park Trading Account.

4 BACKGROUND

4.1 It is proposed to vary the undernoted Traffic Regulation Orders for the reasons listed. All drawings have been made available at the following web link: <http://www.dundee.gov.uk/citydevelopment/trafficorders>. A paper copy can also be made available on request from the Head of Transportation.

a The Dundee City Council (Western Area, Dundee) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) Order 2012

Perth Road (See Drawing 1) - West End Ward

It is proposed to reduce unnecessarily long lengths of "At Any Time" restrictions. After the initial settling in period of the newly re-opened Harris Academy a review of the waiting restrictions was undertaken. It was discovered that the "At Any Time" restrictions west of the school were longer than required.

b The Dundee City Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (On-Street) Order 2011

South Castle Street/South Crichton Street (See Drawing 2) - Maryfield Ward

It is proposed to relocate the disabled parking bays from South Castle Street to South Crichton Street in order to be adjacent the V&A Museum ahead of its completion and to make them more practical for users.

c The Dundee City Council (Eastern Area, Dundee) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) Order 2010

Forthill Road (See Drawing 3) - The Ferry Ward

It is proposed to introduce additional "At Any Time" restrictions to keep sections of the carriageway free from obstruction and allow the free flow of traffic during peak school times.

5 POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- 5.1 This Report has been screened for any policy implications in respect of Sustainability, Strategic Environmental Assessment, Anti-Poverty, Equality Impact Assessment and Risk Management. There are no major issues.
