## 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

This report seeks approval to award grants to local Parent and Toddler groups.

#### 2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Education Committee note the contents of this report and approve the proposed award of grants to Parent and Toddler Groups as outlined in Appendix 1.

#### 3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The full cost of this proposal is £2,050 which will be met from Scottish Executive funding made available to the local authority for Childcare New Projects.

#### 4.0 LOCAL AGENDA 21 IMPLICATIONS

This funding will support and improve access to services, skills and knowledge needed to enable everyone to play a full part in society.

#### 5.0 EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES IMPLICATIONS

This proposal will enhance choice and diversity in early years provision improving equality of access and further strengthening partnership across sectors.

## 6.0 BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE

- 6.1 Parent and Toddler Groups offer parents and their 0–3 year old children an opportunity to play, learn and make new friends in their local area. Groups meet for sessions during the week depending on local circumstances. Parent and Toddler Groups are run by local parents and carers who form committees to plan and organise the programme.
- 6.2 Parents pay an annual membership fee as well as sessional fees. They also organise fund raising events to maintain their activities and pay rents.

#### 7.0 PROPOSAL

- 7.1 The award of grants will enable Parent and Toddler Groups to provide additional resources and play equipment to further promote the learning and development of children aged 0 3.
- 7.2 Applications for grants were made in consultation with the Scottish Pre-school Play Association Co-ordinator who supports the Parent and Toddler Committees. The Coordinator visits the groups on a regular basis and promotes the development of quality and inclusive provision.
- 7.3 In addition the Coordinator attends meetings of the Dundee Early Years and Childcare Partnership and collaborates with members of the Early Years and Childcare Team in supporting and monitoring the progression of targets within the Dundee Early Years and Childcare plan in respect of Playgroups and Toddler Groups.
