1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 To seek authority to purchase a multi purpose mini telescopic handler for the Waste Processing and Recycling Plant at Baldovie within the Waste Management Department.

2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 It is recommended that the committee accept the offer from Scot JCB Ltd.

3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The cost of the machine is £22,890. This will be funded from the Waste Management Department's Capital Budget for 2004/5.

4.0 DUNDEE 21 IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 Health is protected by creating a safe clean pleasant environment.
- 4.2 Pollution is limited to levels with which the natural systems can cope.

5.0 EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES

- 5.1 Under the Local Government Act 1988, suppliers were required to complete and return a questionnaire to ensure that their business complies fully with the Race Relations Act 1976. All companies listed comply fully with the Act.
- 6.0 The Baldovie waste processing and recycling plant processes around 35,000 tonnes of mixed waste per annum. Most of this material is rendered as fuel for the Energy from Waste Plant or sorted as recyclates.
- A system was recently installed into the plant to allow difficult items such as mattresses, sprung furniture, tyres etc, to be processed and this has been very successful. The metal which is extracted from this system is considerable and a small forklift is required to safely service the extracted metal.
- Oundee City Council sought tenders earlier this year for this type of machine. Only one submitted a tender. The equipment tendered has however been on demonstration within the department and evaluated well and is therefore suitable. Details of this tender are attached.
