6.0 ESTIMATED ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE

- Reference is made to the report made to the meeting of Housing Committee held on 30th June, 2003 when expenditure of £446,427.50 was approved in respect of the above project and CFM Building Services Ltd, Carluke were appointed to carry out the work.
- 6.2 At the request of the Director of Housing renewal of the shower cabinets and safety flooring in the bathrooms of the 23 houses in the complex will be added to the contract.

All new piping is to be concealed in ducts, supply cables from the electric meters to the distribution boards will be renewed, kitchen fans will be replaced, the smoke alarms will be linked to the Wardens call system and alterations made to the plumbing installations.

The additional cost of these works is expected to be in the region of £97,500 inclusive of an allowance for professional services.
