1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 The report considers the requirement to keep elected members informed of the changes to the provision of Disabled Persons Parking Places within Dundee.

2 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee note the information contained within this report.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 There are no direct financial implications as a result of this report. All costs relating to Disabled Person's Parking Places will be outlined within separate report which will be requesting permission to vary the existing on and off-street Traffic Regulation Orders for Dundee.

4 BACKGROUND

4.1 The information contained within this report is for the reporting period covering the last financial year (April 2017 – March 2018).

4.2 In the last financial year, Dundee City Council removed 58 disabled on-street parking bays as they were no longer required and added 92 new disabled on-street parking bays. These 92 on-street disabled parking bays are still advisory bays and cannot be enforced until the associated Traffic Regulation Order has been updated.
