1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers the requirement to promote the necessary Traffic Regulation Order to provide an electric vehicle only car park in Princes Street.

2 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the preparation of the necessary Traffic Regulation Order to add Princes Street car park, Dundee to the Order which will provide approximately 18 bays that will only be available to motorists while their vehicles are charging.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The costs of preparing the Traffic Regulation Order is estimated at £2,000. This will be met by the Car Park Trading account.

4 BACKGROUND

4.1 A request has been made by the Fleet Section of the Roads & Transportation Division to add parking provision with a new car park following a grant of £1.86m from the Office of Low Emission Vehicles (OLEV).

4.2 Some of the grant money will be used to provide approximately 18 new electric vehicle only bays which are to be used for charging vehicles only in Princes Street.

4.3 These alterations will require to vary the Dundee City Council (Off-street Car Parks) Order 1996.
