Dundee Active Travel are working with pupils and the school community to encourage travel to school by walking, wheeling, and cycling. The promotion of journeys by active travel is aimed to create a healthier, more enjoyable, and safer route to school. We are also trying to reduce traffic congestion around the school to increase the safety of the school environment.

This map is a great way to map out your active travel journey to school. We would also like to encourage road users to park and stride where possible, as we know not everyone can walk, wheel, or cycle the whole way to school. When parking and striding, please ensure that your vehicle has been parked in an appropriate location, taking care to ensure local residents are not impacted negatively by your actions. By parking and striding, we can keep the school environment free of vehicles and safer for the school community.

Forthill Primary School also hosts an abundance of covered cycle and scooter storage for pupils to make use of, making an active travel journey by cycling or wheeling even easier.
