## **DUNDEE CITY COUNCIL (BIG WEEKEND) (EXEMPTION) ORDER 2023**

DUNDEE CITY COUNCIL, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11(1) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, having consulted the Dundee Local Access Forum and other persons they consider appropriate, having given public notice of the intended purpose and effect of the Order, and having considered any objections and representations made to them, all in accordance with Section 11(2) of the Act HEREBY MAKE the following Order:-

- 1. The Order may be cited as "Dundee City Council (Big Weekend) (Exemption) Order 2023" and shall come into effect at 00.01hrs on 11th May 2023 and will expire at 23.59hrs on 2nd June 2023 inclusive, unless revoked earlier.
- 2. The effect of the Order is to exempt areas of land at Camperdown Park, Dundee, marked as the lorry search compound and the staff residence area both shown outlined in red and hatched in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and a section of Core Path 45, known as Queen Mother's Drive indicated by a solid red line within the Event Main Construction site hatched in blue on the said plan from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of that land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act.
- 3. The purposes for which the Order is made are in relation to (i) the section of Core Path 45, known as Queen Mother's Drive and the area of land forming the lorry search compound providing for public safety and security and (ii) the area of land forming the staff residence area providing for privacy, during the construction and deconstruction of the Radio 1 Big Weekend event infrastructure including temporary stages and buildings, and during the event itself.
