In order for us to provide services to you as a Local Authority, we need you to give us your personal information. Nursery Admissions Guidance Notes for Parents/Carers – Applying for a local authority nursery place

- 1. Applications are prioritised using a points system. If there are any circumstances surrounding your child's needs or family situation which you feel makes your child a priority, please tell us what they are. We need this information to help us to properly consider your application.
- 2. Every effort will be made to allocate your child a place within the nursery or Funded Provider of your choice, but this is not always possible. You are free to apply to any nursery or Funded Provider you wish, however, in the case of local authority nurseries, children usually attend the nursery nearest their home. An application will receive higher priority if the child lives in the local area.
- 3. Please note if there is no space for your child in your first choice of nursery and you choose to stay on the register of applicants of your first-choice nursery and not take up the offer of a 2nd or 3rd choice, then, your child will miss some of their entitlement and this cannot be taken at a later date. Dundee City Council will try to find your child a space in a local authority nursery but is not obliged to offer you your nearest nursery or 1st choice if there is no space.
- 4. It is important to note, that a nursery application **does not** give added weight to a subsequent placing request to a primary school attached to that nursery. If you are out with the catchment area and wish your child to attend Primary One in this school,

please speak directly to the Head of Establishment who will advise on school placing requests.

- 5. Sometimes we need further information to help us to prioritise applications. There may be a number of people e.g. your Health Visitor who can provide more information to support your child's application. Please give us their contact details if you are happy for us to ask them for more information.
- 6. Dundee City Council offer a range of different attendance patterns across the city. Please ask your local nursery for more information.
- 7. If you wish to split your child's place every effort will be made to offer you the blended sessions you prefer. However, you should note that this is not always possible due to the demands of other applicants and the operational difficulties caused by a high level of spilt placements.
- 8. If your child has a blended placement and the total of hours (between the two establishments) exceeds the current weekly entitlement, you will be charged for the additional hours. You must declare this.
- 9. All Dundee City Council Nurseries can offer additional purchased hours subject to capacity. Applications for additional purchased hours' places have to be prioritised due to the high demand. A charging policy is in place for additional purchased hours places.

Appendix 3

Funded ELC for 2-year olds with a parent who has experienced care

From August 2021, local authorities will provide 1140 hours of Early Learning and Childcare to all eligible 3- and 4-year olds and 2-year olds who meet the 2-year-old eligibility criteria, including 2-year olds who have a parent who has experienced care.

Currently "care experienced" can be described as anyone who has been, or is currently in care. This care may have been provided in many different settings, such as: Kinship care – living with a relative who is not your mum or dad; Looked after at home – with the help of social work; Residential care – living in a residential unit or school; Foster care – living with foster carers; Secure care – living in a secure unit.

If you think you experienced being in care at any point in your life and don't meet the other criteria for a two-year-old place, please tick the Care Experienced box on the nursery application form.

Then you will need a confirmation letter from your Local Authority. For Dundee residents, please contact Children and Families Administration on tel. 307940 or csintake.admin@dundeecity.gov.uk and they will provide you with a confirmation letter to give to your child's nursery.
