RIVERSIDE NATURE PARK DECLARATION 2024


DUNDEE CITY COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 19 and 21 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 (“the Act”), and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with NatureScot in accordance with Section 21 of the Act hereby, declares as follows:-

1. This Declaration may be cited as the “Dundee City Council Riverside Nature Park Declaration 2024” and shall come into effect on the Third day of May Two Thousand and Twenty Four.
2. In pursuance of Section 19(2) of the Act, that the land lying to the east of the Invergowrie Burn and comprising the northmost bank of the River Tay situated to the southwest of Riverside Avenue, Dundee and shown outlined and shaded blue on the Plan annexed hereto, being land which is held by the Council, will be managed by them as a Nature Reserve.

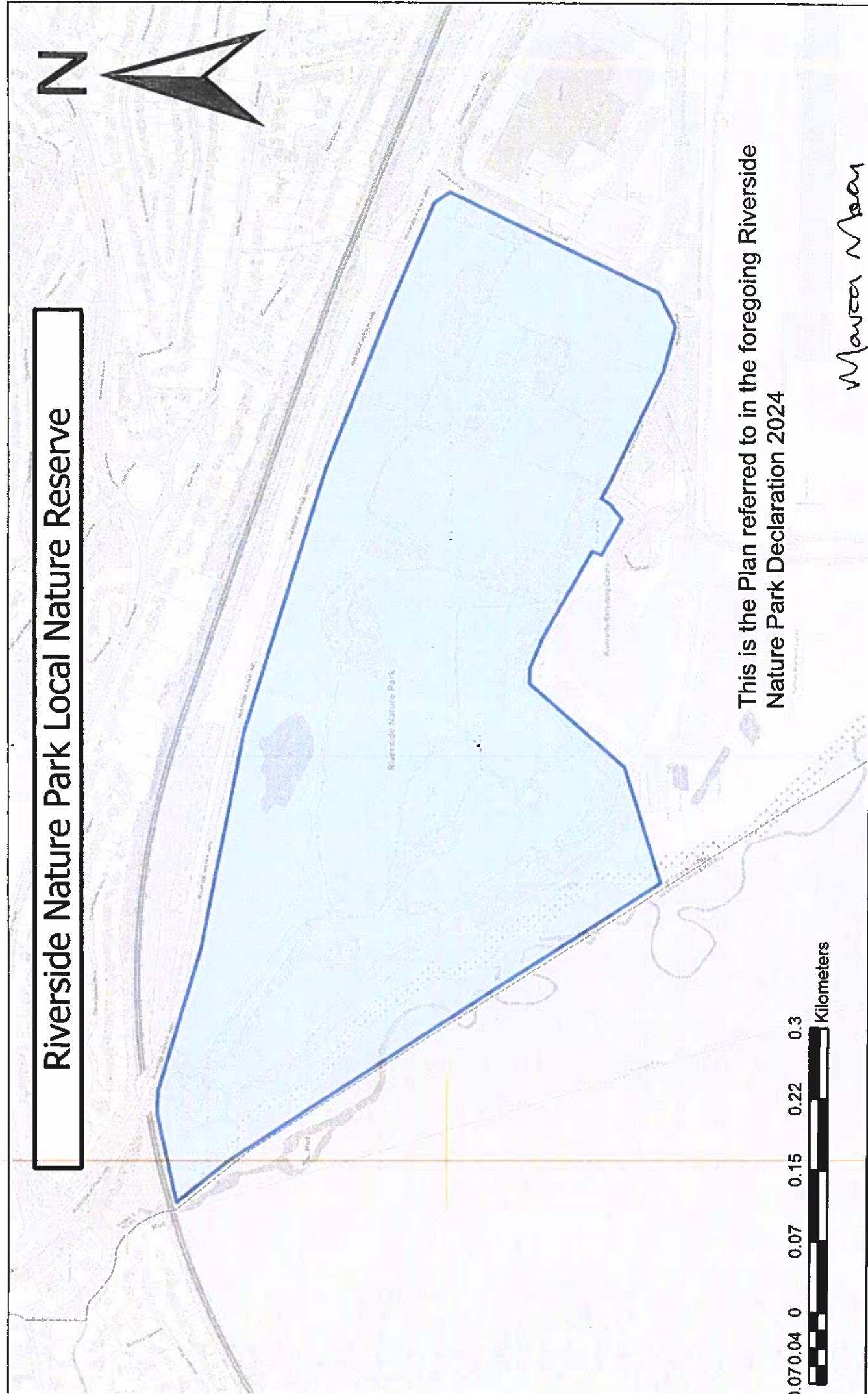
