





The slopes near both Ponds could also remain uncut x1, could extend further south along path parallel to Stobsmuir Road x1, Extend a strip along the w side of the pond that sits near Pitkerro road x1, area near the play park should be kept for picnics etc with a small biodiversity at the top of this. more land could be left, such as around the edges of the rose garden area (outside the path) and perhaps the middle of the triangle x1, should be larger than it is, with paths cut through for access.
