Whitfield to Drumgeith Walk



An easy walk on well made paths with some steep sections.

Directions

From 101 Whitfield Drive follow the path along Whitfield Drive, passing Sun City House. When you reach Drumgeith Road cross to your right at the island and follow the cycle path parallel to Drumgeith Road until you reach the Drumgeith Pavilion. Turn right and follow the path running past the Pavilion to cross the Dighty at the old stone bridge.

Turn right and follow the Green Circular along the Dighty, crossing back at the metal bridge. The path immediately on your left takes you to Pitkerro Road. Cross directly and climb the path alongside Longhaugh Road. At Longhaugh Terrace, turn right and follow the road up the hill, cross to your right at top and keep right to return to 101.

Points of interest

- There was a factory for building sections of the Whitfield flats in the old Longhaugh Quarry
- Look out for Herons at the Dighty Burn
